#### **Learning Objectives:**


1. Define and identify abiotic and biotic factors within the wetland environment.



#### What are abiotic and biotic factors?

**Abiotic factors -** non-living components of an ecosystem. Examples include light, air, soil, temperature, water.

**Biotic factors -** living components of an ecosystem. Examples include fungi, bacteria, plants, animals.


