

Importance of the National Nest Predation Survey

Nest predation rates on turtle nests are very high in many parts of the country, largely due to introduced foxes.

By monitoring the impacts of predation on turtle nests, you will be part of a powerful citizen science network, providing data to improve conservation actions for our freshwater turtles.
