



In a little studio above my garage, I've been mentoring people for over 12 years in the arts of audio production, video production and live event production, as well as creating music with artists from all over the world.

New Spaces and Places

I've been doing this long enough to understand creative work is as much about relationships and people as the actual work itself. The work always ends but relationships, community, stories and people, they go on forever.

In the spring of 2014, a local group of entrepreneurs approached me about increasing the size and scope of what Above Pete's Garage does with people, kids, teams and mentoring. Due to the generosity of Dr. Gary Gray and the Gray Institute, Above Pete's Garage was gifted roughly 2000 square feet of commercial space. This space allows for expanded mentoring and community.

What's In The Works?

- A recording studio space including two control rooms
- A live stage area
- A small teaching theater
- A room for music lessons
- Access to a small film stage
- Access to a green screen stage
- An Artist in Residence program (This program will allow an individual to explore his/her craft in a real world situation without being financially bound. Our first Artist in Residence will be Adrian musician and recording engineer, Logan Witte).

Our style of mentoring is based on:

- Custom one on one teaching
- Small classroom style groups
- Consultations

We hope to incorporate:

- Open nights (songwriting, performance, etc)
- Clinics and summer camps for kids
- Band clinics
- Training for churches and schools and organizations

We teach and model pop style production techniques in:

- Songwriting and recording production
- Live production
- Film making
- Post production for film and audio
- Life planning for artists
- Creativity
- Music lessons

Where will the money go?

The money from this campaign will go towards purchasing gear for the new recording studio, artist in residence studio, vocal booth and music rooms.
