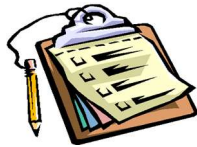




NFRW Political & Campaign Volunteer Awards Program **(Updated - August 2026)**



Hello PVPRWF Members:

As you know, PVPRWF brought back the Volunteer Hours Program at the beginning of this year wherein all local clubs submit their members' volunteer hours to the California Federation of Republican Women (CFRW) for recognition at both the state and national level with National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW).

I want to thank all of you who submitted hours for the time period of January to June 2026! I am also happy and proud to announce that PVPRWF submitted a total of 3,948 hours to NFRW! While that is an excellent number, I am convinced that number could be higher if we had greater participation. Most of you are probably doing things that would count toward our total and perhaps you don't realize it!

GOOD NEWS....NFRW announced a significant upgrade to this program which is now called the Political & Campaign Volunteer Awards program. NFRW has developed a new and more simplistic process for Clubs to report their NFRW Political and Campaign Volunteer Hours and Calls for the 2026-2027 term. In addition to recognition at the Club and State level, Political & Campaign Volunteer Award Winners for each reporting period will be published in the "Capital Connections" and recognized at the NFRW Board of Directors' Meetings. The two-year cumulative award winners will be recognized at the NFRW Biennial Convention that is held every two years.

MID-YEAR LEADER:

By June 30, 2026
Surprise Gift Card

END OF YEAR LEADER:

By December 31, 2026
A Paid Lunch At One Of Our 2027 Meetings

RUNNER-UP END OF YEAR:

By December 31, 2026
A Paid 2027 Membership

Volunteer Awards Activities Published by NFRW

- All time spent at Club, Region, State, and National Federation meetings or conventions (in person or virtual)
- All campaign and political activities benefiting the Federation, the Republican Party, or Republican candidates
- Attendance at all Republican events, including Lincoln Day Dinners, even if tickets were purchased for attendance
- Running for Office (partisan or non-partisan) as a Republican Candidate
- Working on any aspect of a Republican campaign (partisan or non-partisan)
- Working on Republican ballot questions, initiatives, or petitions
- Serving as an elected member of your Local, County, State or National Party Committee
- Attending, preparing for, or volunteering at Club, Region, State, and National Federation meetings or conventions
- Serving on committees
- Attending, preparing for, or volunteering at meetings or conventions of the Local, County, State, and National Republican Party or local meetings or conventions
- Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican office
- Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican candidate or elected official's office
- Working as a non-paid Election Officer, Poll Watcher, Challenger, or Election Integrity worker
- Organizing or teaching a Campaign Management School
- All campaign activities benefiting our Republican Party, candidates, and/or the Federation
- Time spent making Federation, Political and Campaign Calls/Texts
- All Get Out the Vote (GOTV) Door Knocking Campaigns
- Preparing letters to the editor or elected officials
- Researching issues and legislation
- Radio, TV and social media appearances
- Posting to social media
- Voter registration
- Writing or editing a digital or hardcopy State or Club newsletter
- Attendance at rallies
- Any other political or campaign activities
