WHY is EPCHA applying for HUD's RAD program?

The federal government does not provide enough funding to make the improvements that residents of public housing deserve.

EPCHA Capital Needs Long-term:

Translates to millions of dollars



WHY is EPCHA applying for HUD's RAD program?

RAD is a **HUD** program that allows **EPCHA** to:

- Fund major building improvements.
- Stabilize federal funding for the future.

WITH...

- NO resident displacement
- No loss of housing benefits
- No change to rent calculations (30% of income)
- No change in Management



WHAT will EPCHA do?

Scope-of-work may include:

- Apartment renovations (bathroom, kitchens, finishes, storage, new flooring, ceiling fans)
- Update Systems: electrical, plumbing, fire, and mechanical (heating, refrigerated air)
- Energy efficiency measures
- New windows, roofs and building exteriors
- Enhance indoor and outdoor community spaces.
- Improve parking and implement stronger security




EPCHA residents will work along our side to design the improvements!


WHAT will EPCHA do?

- Apartments will remain in same location
- Inventory of units will remain the same
- Phased construction to minimize moves












RAD converts the funding from one type of federal subsidy to another.

After RAD, the subsidy comes to EPCHA in one block (Through the Section 8



RAD allows EPCHA (and its EPCHA owned subsidiaries) to work with partners who want to invest in building improvements

Options available:

- Borrow from a bank
- Issue bonds through city/county or state
- Fundraise from foundations
- Work with other public/private partners

June 2021 EPCHA Board meets to Approve RAD application

June - July 2021

EPCHA submits RAD application to HUD

1 - 3 months

HUD approves application
