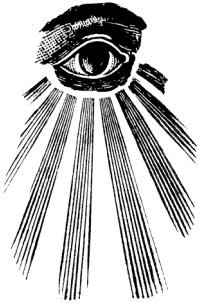

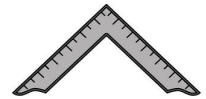
# GREETINGS FROM THE EAST

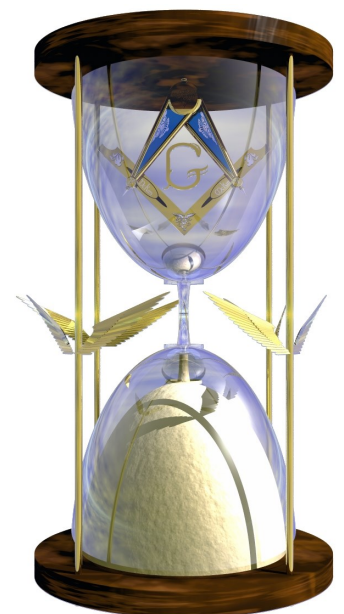
Please join us on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays, with dinner at 6:30, gavel drops at 7:30.

## FROM THE DESK OF THE SECRETARY

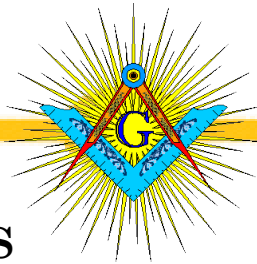

## THE CHAPLAIN'S NOTES

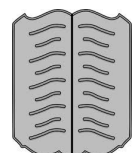
Any of these sound familiar?
