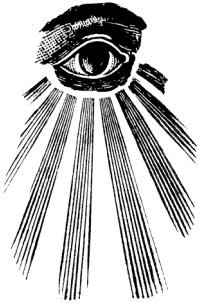

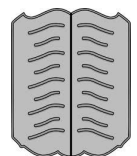
THE CHAPLAIN'S NOTES
