One of the most frequent errors in lodge procedure is the failure of a Warden to raise or lower his column appropriately. Let an absent-minded Warden fail to raise or lower his column as required, and many a frantic gesture from the side lines will remind him of his errant ways!

Almost every Brother sitting in the lodge room knows the proper position of the Wardens' columns during labor or at refreshment, and will hasten to signal a Warden if the emblem of his office is awry. Every Brother knows the simple rule for positioning the Wardens' columns. .

There is no simple explanation of the origin of the Wardens' columns nor what they represent, yet all well informed Brethren will agree that today they are emblematical of the offices of the two Wardens, and represent their authority, of the Senior during labor, and of the Junior while the lodge is at refreshment.

Thus the raising and lowering of the Wardens' columns became sanctioned by custom and Grand Lodge approval. It is not a complicated or mysterious symbolic act; it is a simple means to indicate silently to entering Brethren the status of the lodge.
