#### Musings From A Chaplain

I cannot say that I've never fallen asleep during a sermon. In fact, once upon a time I even dozed, briefly, during a Lodge meeting when a brother went on and on about some topic only he found interesting. In making this confession I am also telling myself that doing so is good for my soul. Yet, after all, who among us can truthfully say his eyes have never grown heavy or his attention zeroed out?



It isn't that a sermon is less inspiring or that the information the brother was providing wasn't important, it is just our nature to sometimes zonk out. Maybe it is because of a heavy meal, or a sleepless night, or a tough day on the job. Whatever the reason for falling asleep, we need to keep in mind that whether in church, in Lodge or somewhere else, it is not polite. It is also bad when you wake up and wonder how long you were out and you begin to worry if anyone else noticed you were asleep.

Be concerned if you are frequently falling asleep in the most inconvenient place or time. The experts say one in four people suffer from some type of sleep disorder. In some cases a sleep disorder can be the symptom of anoth-

er medical or mental health condition. Talk to your doctor and he or she can evaluate why you're falling asleep and what you need to do to correct it. Sleep Apnea is a term we hear most often. It is characterized by pauses in breathing during sleep and is a serious medical condition causing the body to take in less oxygen.

The important thing is, talk to a professional and get some help to stay awake. Everyone needs a good sermon.
