TUITION FEES & PAYMENTS

Tuition rates are for the full season, September-May, not by the number of classes in the month. Fees are paid monthly.

Payments should be made by the 1st of the month, no later than the 7th of the month.

We accept cash or check which may be paid in person at the studio drop box OR at Everwild Flower Market during regular business hours.

There is a costume fee for each spring recital routine. We try to keep the cost per costume under \$60. Dancers may have multiple routines/costumes per class. Costumes must be paid in full before taking them home. If a dancer withdraws from class for any reason after the costumes are ordered, they are still responsible for the costume fees.

If a child is discontinuing classes, a parent or guardian must notify Lakeside in person and complete a withdrawal form by the 1st of the month to stop charges. Parents are financially responsible for tuition until a withdrawal form is received and approved.

Lakeside Dance Company does not offer refunds.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is very important! In order to progress and learn routines, dancers need to be in class every week. We understand that emergencies come up that cause students to miss and we consider these to be excused absences.

Please do not bring sick children to class! Call, text, or email to let us know they will be absent.

Missed classes may cause teachers to change routines. Please make every effort to attend!

Arrive no more than 5-10 minutes before class. This gives dancers time to remove jackets, change shoes, and begin stretching without distracting the current class.

Unless otherwise notified, we ask that parents drop their dancers at the door. We have a very small studio and space is limited!

INCLEMENT WEATHER

The safety of our dancers is of utmost importance and we try to make decisions about canceling classes as far ahead as possible. In the event we must cancel classes, we will notify families by Facebook, email, and text. If needed, make-up days will be scheduled on Saturdays or Sundays.

BEHAVIOR

Dancers are expected to behave in a kind, respectful manner. Remember that students are representatives of Lakeside whether they are in the studio or out in the community. Bullying, poor attitudes, negativity, and unacceptable posts/texts will not be tolerated.

Dancers should be dressed in appropriate dance attire and dance shoes for every class. Hair must be pulled back in a pony tail.

Water bottles are recommended for class. Please do not bring other drinks, candy, snacks, or food into the studio.

We ask that students do not use phones or other electronic devices during class.

Please leave toys and jewelry at home!

WINTER SHOW & SPRING RECITAL

Extra rehearsals and class photos will be scheduled the week prior.

Students must attend dress rehearsals in order to participate.
