Renovation Update

We have received an estimate for HVAC in both the church and for the rectory. The plan is to install about 6 min-split ductless units in the church & one or two ductless mini splits in the lower level of the church. We intend to replace the boiler in the rectory but all the lines will have to be air tested and repairs will be made accordingly. The next step is to seek out grants, donations and or other sources to pay for the installations.

We also have someone who is going to do demolition work in the rectory as well as rebuild services. This will probably cost us a dumpster or two for that particular work.



Military Share Food Distribution Program

Nutritious Food:

While the specific items distributed will vary, each registered family typically receives fresh produce, one quart of fresh milk, one dozen eggs, cheese, and a box of pantry staples such as soup, pasta, sauce, and cereal. When available, meat, fish and poultry products may also be included.

Membership Dues:

The 2024 membership dues began on July 1, 2023, lets try and get 100% membership this year. You can pay on line, at one of our meetings or by mail.

If you did not pay dues last year and you pay for this year, your number of years with the Legion will start from 1.

Presently we have 35 members in our post. 24 members have paid for 2024 putting us just over 68% paid. If you do not pay your dues by January 1, you are delinquent, by February 1 you are suspended, and by June 30th you are dropped from the membership roles.

Letters were sent out in December reminding members to renew for 2024 which we did get responses from.

Membership Dues for 2025.

We just received word from National that there will be a dues increase for 2025. Presently dues are \$35, Current per capita to Department is \$27, \$18.50 to National and the Department gets \$8.50

2025 dues will be increasing from the \$27 per capita rate to \$34, national portion will be \$23.50, with the Department receiving \$10.50.

This means that we will have to raise our dues by \$7 since the national per capita rate is increasing with an additional \$2.0 to the Department. 2025 dues will be raised from \$35 to \$42 beginning July 1, 2025
