The Architect is in the process of working up drawings so we can have a media event with Senator Scavello which will also launch our fund raising campaign..

We started drafting up letters which will go out to potential donors as well as developing a list of those potential donors.

We are considering bricks with peoples names or organizations who donate to the museum which will be part of a walkway.


