
STRUCTURED LITERACY

Summer 2021 Training

Who & Why: Teachers, Parents, Tutors; to build knowledge about best literacy practices to teach/reach all students.

What: Structured Literacy: systematic teaching of reading focusing on word identification and decoding (International Dyslexia Association); -based on the 'Science of Reading'.

When & Where: Aug 10, 11, 12 Virtual & In-Person



Tues Aug 10	<u>Theory</u> (Full Day): Learn rationale concepts behind Structured Literacy (phonology, sound-symbol, syllables, morphology, syntax, semantics) and teaching strategies (explicit instruction, systematic/cumulative, diagnostic).
Wed Aug	<u>Practice</u> (Full Day): How to use theory to adapt current teaching to include Structured Literacy: lesson planning, scope/sequence, centers, groups, etc.
11	Note: This session cannot be taken without first learning 'Theory'.
Thurs	Morphology (AM): Explore: common prefixes/suffixes; how to teach them for
Aug	reading/spelling multisyllabic words to build vocabulary and comprehension.
12	Spelling (PM): How to teach spelling from a Structured Literacy perspective; it is not memorizing letter strings, but using thinking and strategies.
