IS YOUR DRIVER’S LICENSE SUSPENDED? IF SO, HERE IS WHERE TO GO TO APPLY FOR A RESTRICTED LICENSE TO DRIVE AGAIN LEGALLY THEN SET UP A PAYMENT/COMMUNITY SERVICE PLAN PLUS ASK THE JUDGE TO REDUCE YOUR FINES AND FEES.

Call (785)296-3671 or check online to find out the citation numbers on which you still owe and to learn if they have been turned over to a collections agency.

To fill out a “Manifest Hardship” application to request a reduction in your fines and fees for County tickets, go to the County Court House at 525 N. Main, room 714. Once you write your Motion, the Clerk will set a Friday Court date for you to appear.
