



Member Highlights 2018-19

- NREA supported members with two free professional development opportunities for leaders, several national conference sessions, and a powerful STEM partnership with Learning Blade.
- OSRC, AASA and JASON Learning embarked on the creation of the nation's 1st STEM leadership certification program and Ohio cohort for 2019. This cutting edge opportunity for member districts has already brought national attention to Ohio STEM leaders and the work we do, with low cost, high impact grant and curriculum through JASON learning to transform school cultures.
- The 1st OSRC Future Summit last September brought renowned author and speaker Eric Sheninger to Columbus with 4 district teams for a great day of school improvement work.
- Innovation Cohort grants indirectly supported 8 district teams through computer science opportunities through both Tech Corps and TEALS.
- OSRC Tweetchats and Podcasts with partner Allerton Hill has built a following that has grown to over 1000 online and spread the word about our members' work.
- Low cost, high impact blended professional development opportunities with nationally renowned leaders.
- Our first case study article was created by Scioto Scopes to help tell our stories over time, providing national attention for Ohio schools with partners like Rural Schools Collaborative.
- The 2019 Ohio Literacy Summit was a huge success in Southeast Ohio, hosted by the Ohio Valley ESC and several key members!
- Partner EnvisionEd provided free registration to STEM camps in June.
- Featured members on over 16 podcasts so far through partners We Love Schools & Allerton Hill.
- Rural Matters podcast featured Butler County ESC nationally.
- The 2nd Annual Ohio Small & Rural Schools Day was held again March 1. This initiative was created and led by OSRC with support from the Ohio Farm Bureau and Ohio Superintendent DeMaria.
