WHO COULD APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

Candidates for a Women's Motorcycle Association, Network “Dreams of Higher Education, Scholarship” Trunk arty must be a graduating senior, and have been excepted into a College/ University for 2026.

WHAT SHOULD AN APPLICANT SUBMIT?

1. A completed application packet
2. High School transcript
3. Headshot photo of yourself
4. Photo release-written permission
5. College/University acceptance Letter
6. Essay described below
7. Required College readiness course. Also attend a financial literacy course. (transition from high school to college)
8. Parent or guardian letter of agreement

ESSAY

The candidates are required to submit an original essay. Please choose your topic from one of the following:

1. In 10 years you will your late twenties. What will you have accomplished? What will you be doing? What assets would you like to have?
2. In 2025, what are some oft he challenges you experienced to graduate in 2026 The essay should be neatly written or typed in black or blue ink on standard 8 1/2 X 11-inch paper. The candidate's name and date should appear at the top of each sheet. The essay should be double-spaced, in 12- point font, and at least an entire page, or 450-750 words.



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HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

A selection committee will review the applicant's packet. Three committee members will independently review each candidate and assign a score derived from the member ratings.

During the evaluation process, the committee will consider academic performance, leadership ability, financial need, and the quality of written materials. The applicant may be contacted by the committee for additional information as needed.

ABOUT THE ASSOCIATION

The Women's Motorcycle Association Network (WMAN) is a nonprofit association established in 2016 by founder Linnette Thompson. Ms. Thompson's mission is to Inspire and empower youth in underserved communities, accepted into a college or university by providing them with the essentials needed to pursue their dreams of higher education, offering financial literacy courses, scholarships, classroom, and dormitory supplies, Additionally areas such as aiding elderly, feeding and clothing the homeless.

The scholarship started initially to help a young lady who received a scholarship to cover course credits, books, housing food, However, her family did not have the funds to get her to college or to purchase the necessary dorm essentials. Ms. Thompson put a plan in motion to assist the youth With dreams of higher education. The scholarship program has grown over the years and has successfully allowed 100 youths to pursue their dreams of higher education.
