BWRC to celebrate the holidays at a festive luncheon featuring music, gifts and giving

under the tree for these kids who are spending the holidays with strangers and are no doubt lonely, scared and sad.

Please note, donations may not be sent via Zelle.

Also in keeping with the true holiday spirit, gifts will be presented to staff members of Belleair Country Club at the December luncheon on behalf of the BWRC membership to thank them for the exceptional service they have provided over the course of the year.
