Governor Ron DeSantis will be the featured speaker at the BWRC October luncheon

Belleair Women's Republican Club is ridians from harmful impacts of honored to announce the featured speaker at its luncheon on October 3 will be Florida's 46th Governor, Ron DeSantis. With so many issues at play in the state and country and with upcoming critical elections, the luncheon will offer a rare opportunity to hear directly from the man who is at the center of political power in Florida and who also has a national influence. As a leading figure in the conservative movement and in the Republican Party, Governor De-Santis will assuredly have many pertinent and interesting things to share during his presentation.

A native Floridian with bluecollar roots, Governor DeSantis grew up in Dunedin and worked his way through Yale University, where he was the captain of the varsity baseball team, and graduated with honors from Harvard Law School, where he earned a commission in the U.S. Navy as a JAG officer. He deployed to Iraq in support of the SEAL mission in Fallujah, Ramadi, and the rest of the Al Anbar province.

In 2018, Ron DeSantis was elected to be Governor of Florida. As such, he has led across a wide range of issues by successfully navigating Florida through the COVID pandemic, protecting Flo-

illegal immigration, expanding school choice, promoting public safety (with a record 50-year crime low in the state), keeping Florida's economy strong, ensuring road improvement projects are fully funded and ahead of schedule, and making historic investments in environmental conservation and stewardship.

Thanks to the Governor's efforts, Florida ranks #1 for economy (among all 50 states); for education (two years in a row); for higher education (eight years in a row); for attracting and developing a talented workforce; for parental empowerment and educational freedom; for tourism and net in-migration; and for law enforcement recruiting and support.

Governor DeSantis is married to Casey DeSantis, an Emmy Award-winning television anchor. Together, they're the proud parents of their daughters, Madison and Mamie, and their son, Mason.

The October luncheon will not be open to the public. It will be a private event for members of BWRC and their personal guests whose names must be submitted with the member's payment. There will be absolutely no walk-



ins allowed, and members are advised to reserve a seat early as space is limited and likely to sell out. Members are also asked to not share copies of this newsletter with non club members or spread news of this luncheon to the general public, including on social media. A security detail will be present and every measure will be taken to make sure everyone is safe, so please do not bring personal firearms and obey all instructions from the Governor's staff and security force.

The October 3 BWRC luncheon will be held at Belleair Country Club, 1 Country Club Lane, Belleair. Check-in begins at 11:30 am, with lunch served starting at noon. The cost to attend is \$38 per person with reservations and payment due no later than Thursday, September 18. Belleair Women's Republican Club has lost one of its longest-term and most loyal members. Carol Bumiller, a member of BWRC for more than 30 years, died August 10. Carol held many offices and filled numerous other leadership roles in the club over the years. She was a passionate Republican, she supported countless state, county and national candidates contributing funds and doing whatever needed to get them elected. She rarely missed a BWRC meeting, and even when quite ill made the effort to attend if at all possible. She could always be found holding court in a specific seat at what everyone knew was "Carol's table". She was also an active and loyal member of the Pinellas Republican Executive Committee, held membership in its Ivory Club and was a board member of the Suncoast Tiger Bay Club.



A strongly opinionated woman, Carol could seem tough, but at her core she was a caring, compassionate person. In her community, Carol, a retired nurse, was a consistent force for good throughout her life. Among other things, she was a member of the Mid County Council of the Juvenile Welfare Board; a Boley's Angel supporting the work of St. Petersburg's Boley Center which helps individuals with mental disabilities, the homeless and veterans; was a member if the Children's Home Society; was very active with Parc Center for Disabilities; and served on the development board of LiFT, a school for autism in Seminole.

Services were held August 30 at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church, and Carol's life was also celebrated and honored at the September BWRC and Pinellas GOP meetings.

We are all so fortunate to have known you. Rest in peace, dear friend.


