## **Pinellas County Board Chair to** speak at March **BWRC luncheon**

The Pinellas Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is the elected body that oversees Pinellas County Government. The State constitution gives BCC the power to adopt ordinances (local laws), approve the County budget, set property tax millages departments under its control. The Board governs all unincorporated areas of the county directly. The BCC approves support funding for court services and approves the budgets of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, the Sheriff and the Motorcoach Group. In his public Supervisor of Elections.
