

Social Media Kings and Queens Program

Riverton holds a monthly social media competition to encourage students to create social media content which is focused on student life in Australia. 
One-on-One English Coaching

Riverton provides individual and personalised feedback regularly to all students free of charge. In week 4 and week 8, teachers meet with students for their "one-on-one" Full Potential Coaching session. Teachers give individual feedback and advice to students and discuss their achievement which sets targets and goals for the student to concentrate on. If the teacher identifies that a student is not progressing, the Academic Manager is informed in order to provide further support or intervention strategies, if required.



STEM Club

Riverton holds free fortnightly STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics) workshops with a specialist STEM teacher. The workshops are covering a broad range of STEM related topics including science experiments, robotics, virtual and augmented reality, coding and cultivating a home garden.

Riverton provides FREE, authentic IELTS Exam testing to current students. This allows students to complete one FREE IELTS for every 10 weeks enrolled at Riverton.



Aussie Grandparent Program




Job Club
