

Additional Fees for Watercolor Painting Class

Overview

Participating in a watercolor painting class may involve small additional fees for materials and resources provided by the instructor. Please bring any supplies you have. A supply list is also provided on Relaxandpaint.com.

The following is a detailed breakdown of costs to help students plan accordingly. These fees, if applicable, will be collected at the end of class where the instructor provides additional materials. Start with the basics and use recommended brands for better results and success. The recommended supply list is extensive. You can purchase small tubes of paint and build your supplies gradually.

Fee Breakdown

- Watercolor Paper:
 - \$5 for a half sheet of professional-grade watercolor paper. A professional-level paper ensures quality and durability for student practice and finished pieces. A half sheet may be broken down into two 11 x 14 or four 7 x 5.5 paintings.
- Supply Use Fee: If you're just getting started, a loaner palette is FREE for the first few classes. Occasionally, we may use other supplies (like gesso, gouache, etc.), and a \$3 supply use fee might apply.
- Starter Palette: \$30 for a small starter palette with professional-grade watercolor paints. The palette is ideal for beginners seeking high-quality materials to learn and create.
- Color Copies are \$1 per copy.
