Weather Warning Siren –

- The Weather Warning Siren will be a 3 minute continuous blast per F.E.M.A. standards. This system will be tested at 10:30 a.m. on the first Tuesday of the month with all the other warning systems in the county for 3 minutes.

Fire Siren –

- The fire siren will be used to notify members of the Naplate Volunteer Fire Department that their assistance is being needed. The Fire Siren will be a series of repetitive short blasts each about 6 seconds long lasting 40 seconds total.

Hazardous Material Incident –

- In the unlikely event of a hazardous material incident in the village or the surrounding area a high/low blast will sound for 3 minutes.

P.A. System –

- A P.A. System will be used for emergency instructions in various situations. The P.A. System will cover the same distance as the other warning systems. There will be an airhorn that will be used before the announcement to help gain peoples attention.
