As the school year comes to a close, the Frenchtown Community Coalition is grateful for the opportunity to collaborate with students, families, school partners, and local businesses to support safe, memorable experiences for Frenchtown youth.

This spring, FCC partnered with the prom planning committee to help make prom night fun, safe, and meaningful for FHS students. FCC covered the cost of the prom venue at The Wilma, provided every student who purchased a prom ticket with a \$5 Big Dipper voucher, and sponsored after-prom bowling at Westside Lanes from 10:00 PM to midnight. We were so excited to see 26 lanes full of Frenchtown students, and we were incredibly proud of how respectful and kind they were throughout the evening.



The day before prom, the Student Mental Health & Substance Use Task Force also participated in Sticker Shock at Broncs Grocery. This project helps remind adults that providing alcohol to minors is illegal and encourages the community to work together to keep students safe during high-risk times like prom and graduation season. Thank you to Broncs Grocery for welcoming our students and supporting this prevention effort.



FCC is also proud to cover the cost of the City Life Community Center for the Senior All Night Party, helping provide another safe, substance-free space for students to celebrate an important milestone together.
