Strategic Prevention Framework— Partnerships For Success Grant

We have exciting news! The Frenchtown Community Coalition (FCC) was recently awarded a five-year, \$1.25 million federal grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). The Strategic Prevention Framework – Partnerships for Success (SPF-PFS) grant provides \$250,000 per year through 2030 and will allow FCC to expand prevention and wellness education across all grade levels in the Frenchtown School District. This grant combines substance-use prevention with mental-health promotion, supporting a district-wide K–12 approach that focuses on strengthening protective factors, building coping skills, and helping students make healthy choices. According to SAMHSA, up to 12 states and 41 communities across the country receive this grant. The FCC is grateful to be among them.

Funding will support data-driven strategies, school and community training opportunities, and student-led initiatives designed to build leadership and reduce youth substance use. It will also allow FCC to monitor local trends and tailor prevention strategies based on the evolving needs of our students and community.

As this work moves forward, FCC will continue partnering with Frenchtown Schools, families, youth, and community organizations to ensure prevention remains a shared effort.

We are thrilled to receive this grant and can't wait to see the positive impact it will have on Frenchtown youth and families in the years ahead.
