


2018 NATIONAL VW BUG-IN

Details

The 2018 National Bug-In will be held over Easter 2018 in the historic and picturesque Victorian regional City of Ballarat. This four day event will be co-hosted by the Volkswagen Club of Victoria Inc and the Ballarat Volkswagen Club Inc. The event commences on the afternoon of Good Friday 30 March 2018 and concludes on Monday 2 April 2018 at around lunchtime.

During those four days there will be a range of activities that will provide all participants an opportunity to mix with members from local and interstate VW clubs, participate in a welcome event, a choice of a cruise to Bendigo to be involved in the Bendigo VW Club's Easter Car Show, a local Goldfields Cruise or a local wine or beer tasting experience, a car show and sausage sizzle on the shore of Lake Wendouree, a dinner with professional floor show entertainment and a pancake breakfast held at the home of two local VW identities. An outline of the proposed events are listed in this notice and more details will be made available as soon as possible.

Suggested accommodation venues are listed below. The Mercure Hotel is where the dinner and floor show will be held and it is offering reduced accommodation prices to event participants. The Big 4 Ballarat Goldfields Holiday Park and the Ballarat Suites are within walking distance to the Mercure Hotel.

If you intend to participate in what will be a great VW Bug-In event it is very important that you make accommodation bookings as soon as possible. As this event is held over Easter any accommodation vacancies in and around Ballarat will be filling fast. The registration fee for the event, or any part, will be \$15 per head. 2018 BUG IN TOUR

To commence on Tuesday 3 April and conclude on Saturday 7 April 2018



- A total distance of around 1350 kms will be travelled on this tour. A mixture of goldfields, high country, mountain, rural and seaside perspectives of Victoria.
- It will be conducted at a leisurely pace with plenty of time for you, your passengers and your VW to enjoy the cruise and take in the sights.
- Notable places of interest that will be visited include the Tank Museum at Puckapunyal Army Base, King Valley and its wineries, the high country scenery into Bright, the Bright Micro-Brewery, the ascent and descent of Mount Hotham, Lakes Entrance, its fishing fleet and its seafood, Tarra Bulga National Park, Port Albert Maritime Museum and the Vietnam Veterans Museum at Newhaven on Phillip Island.
- You will need to be a member of the Volkswagen Club of Victoria Inc, one of the
 other Victorian VW clubs or one of the interstate VW clubs to participate. Once you
 book on the tour we suggest that you book your accommodation as soon as possible
 as it will be school holidays and some venues may have limited accommodation
 availability. Tell them you will be with the Volkswagen group.
- You are advised to get in early or you may miss out. The tour is limited to a maximum of 20 VWs.
- You will need to contact the organiser (see details below) and make arrangements to lodge the tour fee of \$15 per person to secure your participation and help cover tour merchandise, giveaways and a few surprises that will be distributed at the start and during the tour.
