**Athlete Code of Conduct:** As a representative of Stones Crossing Swim Club, all swimmers and divers are expected to behave in a respectful manner and display good sportsmanship to team members, competitors, coaches, officials, parents and staff.

Athletes agree to:

- Obey the rules of the ABE Suburban Swimming and Diving League
- Obey the rules of the respective swim club or country club facilities during team events
- Be respectful to teammates, display good sportsmanship, and promote positive team spirit
- Bullying is prohibited including at team events or on social media
- Refrain from use of profane language during practices, meets or team activities
- Respect the facility personnel and property during practices, meets and team activities
- Follow directions and be respectful to coaching staff, participate and try your best at practice and meets
- Respect officials and volunteers during meets without them it would not be possible
- Direct any concerns related to meets, practice or otherwise to the coach or swim team coordinator

**Parent Code of Conduct:** As a representative of Stones Crossing Swim Club, all parents are expected to behave in a respectful manner and set a good example for their children on the team.

Parents agree to:

- Obey the rules of the ABE Suburban Swimming and Diving League
- Obey the rules of the respective swim club or country club facilities during team events
- Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all swimmers, divers, coaches and officials during practices or meets
- Please do not interrupt coaches during practice or go on deck during practice
- Respect officials and volunteers during meets without them it would not be possible
- Direct any concerns related to meets, practice or otherwise to the coach or swim team coordinator
