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PUMPKIN PLAYDOUGH

Materials Needed

- 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- ³/₄ cup salt
- 1 ½ teaspoon cream of tartar
- 1 tablespoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1 ½ cups water
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- optional orange food coloring
- large cooking pot (or saucepan)
- spoon
- wax paper
- Add ingredients to saucepan. Stir to combine.
- Continue to stir the ingredients. Heat over medium heat for 4-5 minutes.
- Cool and add coloring.
- Knead the dough and enjoy!

SENSORY PICKS


