Start with what you know the child likes and go from there.

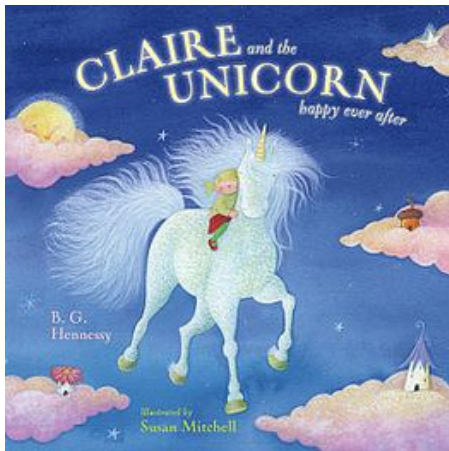

The Toniebox



TO BUY

The Toniebox is an audio player for kids for screen-free listening (YAY!) with an easy to use design that even the youngest child (2+) can operate. Playback starts when Tonie characters are placed on the Toniebox. There are HUNDREDS of characters to choose from. Including Corduroy!

Surprised I'm recommending anything electronic? You should be, I am not a fan of electronic anything for young children. BUT once the Toniebox is charged via a USB cable it is moveable and durable.

The characters range in price from \$10-20, and playing time from 30 min-90 minutes. Most include stories and music and there are free downloads on the app. For you LONG DISTANCE GRANDPARENTS- you can buy a "Creative Tonie" for \$10 and record yourself reading, for up to 90 minutes. It's all done on the app. You can add a story whenever you want.

A Bubble Machine

OK, this needs to be plugged in. so that makes two gifts that require some power. Great when kids need a little change of pace. Who doesn't like to dance to a bubble party? You might want to stock up on bubble mix.

Anything for Outside Play

This can be anything from a push toy, scooter, bike, skates, mud kitchen, water table, swing set, garden tools, etc. It's IMPORTANT for kids be play outside. So this is one of my "go-to" categories for grandchildren gifts.
