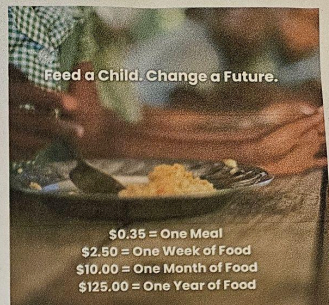


FBC Bethany would like to invite your church to be part of our Mission of Hope Meal Packing Event.
