


2. Why is commuting by two wheeler to the college not allowed?

ampus placement or campus interview is the programme conducted within educational institutes or in a common place to provide jobs to students pursuing or in the stage of completing the programme. In this programme, industries visit the colleges to select students depending on their ability to work, capability, focus and Aim.

Types of Campus Placement

There are two types of campus placement. They are on-campus and off-campus

Pool campus

This job placement program is conducted within a group of colleges and in this job is given as an off campus placement.

This job placement program is for students from other institutions. This program will be conducted in a common place (it may be in a college or in some public place) where students from different colleges will take part.

Project Placement

Companies recruit students to do their academic project in the interiors industrial environment.

Student Internship Placement

Companies recruit the students as interns. Internship will be during their student is out.

Objective

The major objective of campus placement is to identify the talented and qualified professionals before they complete their education. This process reduces the time for an industry to

pick the candidates according to their needs. It is a cumbersome activity and hence majority of the companies find it difficult to trace the right talent.

The basic thing one requires for attending interview is Educational qualification which included marks, grade or specific program. One should have subject knowledge, aptitude, fluency in English, good communication skills and self-confidence.

If we are qualified in educational qualification, we undergo written test (aptitude test) and the range of difficulty depends on the company .After written test we get selected into group discussion which is filtering round .In this topic may be given on technical or general. If students are qualified in above two rounds, they get chance of attending technical interview, this round evaluates the technical ability of the student.

Sometimes technical interview is grouped with formal interview. Formal interview is the final round of selection process which focuses on overall personality of the candidate.

Post-Placement Talk

Once the student is selected, he will be given an offer letter. Company's executive may provide guidelines about joining procedure and other prerequisites if needed.

Some Basic Interview Questions

- Tell me about yourself?
- What are your strengths?
- Why do you want this job?
- What do you know about our company?
- What was the most difficult period in your life and how did you deal with it?
- What is your greatest failure, what did you learn from it?
- What would be your ideal working environment?



HOW STUDENTS DEVELOP ONLINE LEARNING SKILLS

ore and more, adult learners are finding the convenience and flexibility of online learning a match for their learning goals and busy lifestyles. Online degree programs, courses, and virtual universities targeting adult learners have proliferated in the past decade Educators have speculated on the development of student skills necessary to succeed in online learning, but relatively few publications cover the topic from the perspective of successful online students.

The study began with the development of a set of questions that emerged from a group of online course designers, faculty, and administrators as consulted for ideas. The question set was reviewed and edited by a larger group of faculty and administrators, and an online survey instrument was developed. Participants for this study were selected from a list of graduates who had earned their degrees by taking 80 percent or more of their courses exclusively online. Students responding to the survey agreed on a number of practical steps that helped them succeed in their online courses:

Online degree programs, virtual COULSES and universities targeting adult learners have proliferated in the past decade Educators have speculated on the development of student skills necessary to succeed in online learning, but relatively few publications cover the topic from the perspective of successful online students

Successful Online Students Identify Seven Tips:

1. Develop a time-management strategy.



Students were asked what time-management strategies they found most helpful. One challenge facing an online student is the self-discipline required to devote adequate time to class in courses that

might not have regularly

Scheduled times to meet synchronously online or in person.

2. Make the most of online discussions.

Student interaction mostly occurs through an online threaded discussion that allows students and instructors to interact in asynchronous time. This is a significant shift for



students accustomed to in-class discussions. It may provide opportunities for richer discourse through written discussion that allows students to spend time crafting their responses

3. Use it or lose it.



One challenge some students face when learning online is retention of the course content. Students surveyed agreed that finding a way to apply the concepts helped them retain the information.

The question set was reviewed and edited by a larger group of faculty and administrators, and an online survey instrument developed. was Participants for this study were selected from a list of graduates who had earned their degrees by taking 80 percent or more of their courses exclusively online. Students responding to the survey agreed on a number of practical steps that helped them succeed

in their online courses:




4. Make questions useful to your learning.

By asking questions, fellow students and instructors would go deeper into the subject. Going deeper made the subject matter more understandable.



5. Stay motivated.



Without direct physical contact and interaction with other learners or an instructor, online students can lose their interest or motivation mid-way through their course or program.

6. Communicate the instruction techniques that work.

Instructors in online courses employ a variety of techniques aimed at engaging learner. This could be helpful to succeed.



7. Make connections with fellow students.



Being part of a community of learners is helpful in courses that are taught in-person, and the same holds true for online classes. The experience was enriched greatly by the relationships and interaction with fellow students.

Summary

The responses these successful online students highlight several techniques instructors can use to help their students develop effective online learning skills. No magical formula quarantees success in online learning. One important step for instructors teaching an online course is to recognize that a different set of student skills may be required for students to get good grades (indicating that they have achieved the desired understanding of the subject) and to get the most from an online course. The techniques identified by successful students online can promote a rich learning experience for other students and provide a foundation for them to develop these skills. Instructors can help them aet there.





FILM ZONE: PSYCHO - A CLASSIC CRIME STORY

sycho (1960) was directed by Alfred Hitchcock and starred Anthony Perkins, Vera Miles, John Gavin, and Janet Leigh. The screenplay is by Joseph Stefano.

In Psycho, Alfred Hitchcock not only created a blazing masterpiece and spawned a new cinematic genre – the slasher. He also delivered one of the boldest blows in screen history. It was not just how he killed Janet Leigh's Marion Crane, astonishing though that was – it was when.

The film is 109 minutes long, but he offs his heroine, the glamorous miscreant with whom he's made us identify, after just 47. In 1960, this generated, by all accounts, an unprecedented sense of careering into uncharted and terrifying territory: what the hell would happen next? Even now, it's distinctly unnerving.

That said, Marion Crane's now-famous end in the shower — made up of 70 camera set-ups and 78 pieces of film, with no actual shot of the knife piercing flesh — is very nearly matched for shock value by the later dispatching of Detective Arbogast as he explores the motel on Marion's trail. And, although the trick is simpler here, it's no less powerful.



As soon as the policeman reaches the top of the stairs, Hitchcock cuts disorient tingly to a bird's-eye view of the landing, and then, before we've had even a second to get our bearings, a figure darts into view from the right of the screen, knife raised. No matter how prepared you are, how many times you see it, it's almost impossible not to flinch.

Hitchcock's mischievous genius for audience manipulation is everywhere: in the nourish angularity of the cinematography, in his use of Bernard Herrmann's stabbing string score, in the ornithological imagery that creates a bizarre sense of preying and being preyed upon. Was he also subconsciously warming up for his next project, The Birds?

The creatures are everywhere in Psycho, from the aerial shots, to Marion's surname, to the town where the action begins (Phoenix), to the hideous taxidermy looming on Norman's walls, and even his world-view. "I think that we're all in our private traps," says Norman (the terrifying, touching Anthony Perkins). "We scratch and we claw, but only at the air, only at each other, and for all of it, we never budge an inch."

The audience is similarly helpless in Hitchcock's "trap" – but you wouldn't have it any other way.




