

Camp Rules for LSMC 2019

Rules for students:

- We have some specific guidelines that will help everything to run on time and efficiently. Only go into the room assigned on your schedule at the time listed.
- During lunch, students need to be respectful of others and not wasteful with the food.
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- In order to limit damage to your instrument and the property here at Forest Hills, we have one basic property rule: If it's not yours, don't touch it. If something is broken or needs attention, tell a teacher or counselor. If you're curious about something ASK, just don't touch. Please don't put anything on the pianos or other musical instruments like the timpani.
- Be respectful of others and their things.
- No running in the halls
- Bass players, cellists and students with health issues are allowed to use the elevator.
- Students are not allowed to take pictures at camp and post them on social media.
- Students are not allowed to bring knives, weapons, firearms, weapons, flammable liquids, explosives or fireworks to camp. Tobacco, alcohol and illegal drugs are prohibited.
- Students, you will need to be checked in when arriving in the morning by a parent or the person authorized to drop you off. Don't go to class before signing in.
- At the end of the day, wait for your parent or the person authorized to pick you up to check you out in the lobby before leaving the building.
- All Campers need to wear their name tags every day.

Guidelines for Parents:

- Make sure your child's instrument is labeled.
- You will need to check your child in and check your child out each day. The check in sheet will be in the lobby. The check-out sheet must be signed by you or the person you have authorized to pick up your child at the end of the camp day from the auditorium. Your child will only be released to you or a person designated on the Camper Pick-Up Authorization form. The check-out sheet will be in the lobby. If alternative plans for pick up are made (for example, your child and another student are going to carpool), please let us know in the office ahead of time.
- Camp begins at 8:30 am during Session 1 and 9:00 a.m. during Session 2. Morning Drop off can be a half hour earlier. Campers should bring a book to read or something to do before camp starts. Pick up time for regular campers is 3:00, 4:30 for honors students, and 5:00 for extended day campers. On Thursday the regular camp day will end at 3:15 following the honors chamber music performances. Extended day will end at 5:00 and the Honors students will perform at their outreach locations following the Meredith performance on Thursday.
- **The Session 1 concert on June 14 will start at 9:00 and end at 11:00.** Students need to **arrive at 8:15 am**. PLEASE NOTE: It will be held in **JONES AUDITORIUM on the MEREDITH COLLEGE CAMPUS**. Camp will conclude at the end of concert.
- **The Session 2 concert on Friday June 21 will begin at 9:00am** but campers will need to arrive at 8:30. This concert will be held at **FOREST HILLS BAPTIST CHURCH** and last about two hours. Camp will conclude at the end of the concert Friday morning.
