Scriptural Basis:

- John 3:16
 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

 - Isaiah 9:6—Isaiah prophesies that Jesus Christ will come as a baby; Jesus is described by several names.
 - Micah 5:2—Micah prophesies that Jesus will be born in Bethlehem.

 - Luke 2:4-7

1. Q. What is Salvation?
A. Deliverance from the power and penalty of sin.
2. Q. What constitutes salvation?
A. Grace. (Ephesians 2:8 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
3. Q. Who are the objects of salvation?
A. Sinners.
4. Q. Through what medium does salvation come to the sinner?
A. Through the mediatorial offices of the Son of God.
5. Q. What are the mediatorial offices of the Son of God?
A. Prophet, Priest and King.
6. Q. What is a Prophet?
A. One who speaks forth for God.
7. Q. What is a priest?
A. One who offers sacrifices.
8. Q. What is a King?
A. One who rules.
9. Q. What was necessary for Christ to do in order to secure salvation?
A. To die and make atonement.
10. Q. What is atonement?
A. It is satisfaction rendered to the law for some injury.
11. Q. Who did Christ make this atonement to?
A. To divine justice.
12. Q. What part did the sinner receive?
A. The benefits.
13. Q. Where is Christ now?
A. He is enthroned in Heaven

14. Q. What do you mean by enthroned?
A. To be seated upon a throne.
15. Q. What makes Him so wonderful?
A. He is God and Man.
16. Q. What makes Him all sufficient Saviour?
A. He is in every way qualified to be a Saviour.
17. Q. What are the qualifications He possesses?
A. All qualifications necessary for salvation.
18. Q. Name some of them?
A. Power, wisdom, holiness, mercy, justice, truth and immutability.
