

1. Q. What is the Bible?  
A. Book containing the revelation of God to man.
2. Q. What kind of Book is the Bible?  
A. It is a Holy Book
3. Q. Why is it called a Holy Book?  
A. Because it contains the Holy Scriptures.
4. Q. How many general parts are there into which the Bible is divided?  
A. Two.
5. Q. What are they?  
A. The Old and New Testaments.
6. Q. What is a testament?  
A. It is a will.
7. Q. When is the will enforced?  
A. After the death of a testator.
8. Q. How was the Old Testament enforced?  
A. By prayers, types and shadows.
9. Q. Into how many parts is the bible divided as to matter?  
A. It is divided into five parts.
10. Q. What are they?  
A. They are Law, History, Poetry, Prophecy and Doctrine.
11. Q. How many Law books have we in the Old Testament?  
A. Five
12. Q. How many historical books are in the Bible?  
A. Twelve
13. Q. How are the Prophets divided?  
A. Into two classes.

14. Q. What are they?  
A. Major and Minor.
15. Q. How many Major Prophets have we?  
A. Four
16. Q. Why call them major prophets?  
A. Because they wrote more extensively.
17. Q. How many prophetic books are in the Bible?  
A. Seventeen
18. Q. How do you account for the Seventeen Books?  
A. Because one prophet wrote two; namely Jeremiah and Lamentations. The Prophetic Books of the Bible begin with Isaiah and end with Malachi.
19. Q. What principles does the Bible reveal to us?  
A. The principles by which we shall be judged.
20. Q. How long shall these principles stand?  
A. To the end of the world.
21. Q. What kind of standard is the Bible?  
A. It is a supreme standard.
22. Q. By this standard what ought to be tried?  
A. All human conduct, creeds and opinions.
23. Q. What kind of center is the Bible?  
A. It is a true center of Christian Union.
24. Q. What is a creed?  
A. A summary of Christian beliefs.
25. Q. Are there any errors in the Bible?  
A. No, because it is truth without mixture of error for its matter.
26. Q. How many poetical books are in the Bible?  
A. Five. (Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes and Song of Solomon)
27. Q. How many books are in the Bible?  
A. Sixty-Six (66)

28. Q. How many books are in the Old Testament?  
A. Thirty-Nine (39)
29. Q. How many books are in the New Testament?  
A. Twenty-seven (27)
30. Q. How long was the Bible being written?  
A. Sixteen centuries (16)
31. Q. How many men wrote the Bible?  
A. Thirty-six or more.
32. Q. What kind of men wrote the Bible?  
A. They were Holy or Inspired. (Inspired means to breathe on or breathe into).
33. Q. The Bible is made of three components, what are they?  
A. History, Doctrine, and Prophecy.
34. Q. How many doctrinal books are in the new testament?  
A. Twenty-one (21) Romans - Jude
35. Q. What is the great end of the Bible?  
A. Salvation
36. Q. What does the Bible teach?  
A. The will of God, our duty to Him and to the fellowman.
37. Q. What is the matter of which the Bible is composed?  
A. Truth
