Loran Steinlage, will discuss how he uses strip tillage, diverse cover mixes, spring covers, and inter-seeded cover crops to improve his Iowa farm.

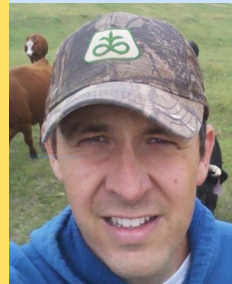


Jimmy Emmons, a recovered tillage addict from Oklahoma, will explain how he uses no-till, cover crops, and a diverse rotation to improve soil health.
