

Small Taxing Unit Notice

The City of Millsap (Name of Taxing Unit) will hold a meeting at 4pm (Time)
 on August 29th (Date) at Millsap City Hall - 208 Fannin (Location)
 to consider adopting a proposed tax rate for tax year 2023 (Year). The proposed tax rate is
.38 (Rate) per \$100 of value.
