I was the sole sound recordist on this series using PSC kit to record presenter led documentary footage in a variety of differing often "sound inclement locations".

A six part Channel Four series looking at UK aviation with the presenter Arthur Williams flying his vintage aircraft across the UK. I not only recorded all the documentary sound but also designed and operated the bespoke system used in the open cockpit aircraft for Arthur to narrate and present the programme whilst flying.

Staging a concert for the first time in Camp Bastion and filming it was a huge technical and logistical challenge but having overcome many hurdles myself and a small team helped to deliver a remarkable soundtrack to the programme as well as providing live PA sound for the concert to approx. 1000 troops.

Fighting The War

For the first time in 2003 documentary crews were embedded with the British Military forces as the Second Gulf War was fought in Iraq, to show just how a war is fought. With total access to the whole machine from the Secretary of state for defence through the chain of command this insightful documentary series shows just what it takes to actually direct and supply the military forces.

I was embedded with the British Army in front line positions to the south of Iraq and was the first non military person to actually step into Southern Iraq as the borders were breached winning both a military service medal and a Royal Television Society Award for my work.
