#### **Previous Meeting's Minutes**

## **Financial Report**

-- Post financial report, referencing checking account balance of \$ 15,927.87 savings account balance of \$ 5.00, and certificate of deposit account balance of \$ 10,582.69, total account balance of \$ 26,515.56 was approved.

Post 501 will be presenting two (2) awards. Poppy distribution scheduled on 10,11,12 May at same six merchants as last year. Memorial Day Program planning committee continues to meet in discussing and finalizing plans for the event.
