Meeting Minutes 25 September 2025

Mike Buchan Veteran Service Officer for Washington County. Mike spoke about the new service center in Woodbury and how they hope to be able to staff this one day a week. He also provided information on several programs and on a current scam going on for applying for disability payments through the VA. There are currently individuals who will charge for this service with the guarantee that you will be approved. They are not legitimate. - **Joint Annual Picnic**
Paul is not here to give us an update on the cost. Another VFW member was present and stated that he did not believe there were any outstanding expenses for the picnic.
- **Sept Poppy Days**
September Poppy Days went well. There were a few things that were discussed. The main topic was the need for the QR code to be at all sites, and the inclusion of information on both the Legion and VFW for all sites. It was determined that a packet with all this information will need to be included in all of the boxes for next year.

New Business

- **Woodbury Newcomer Event - 23 October – Volunteers**
The Woodbury Newcomer event is scheduled for 23 October 2025 at the MHealth/Fairview building. CDR Dolan is looking for volunteers to staff this event, and he will need some extra assistance in setting up as he recently broke his right arm and will be unable to lift things. Bob W and Tim agreed to contact CDR Dolan and arrange for transfer and setting up of equipment. Jo and Teresa agreed to also staff the event.
- **Portable Sound System**
The portable sound system that we are looking to purchase was described by Vice Commander Kramer as she had just been shown it by the rep. A motion was made that we go ahead and purchase the equipment and ask the VFW to assist with the purchase. The motion passed unanimously, and Vice Commander Kramer will talk with CDR Dolan to make the purchase.
- **Wall of Thanks**
Tim Creer was asked about the Wall of Thanks. He has taken this over from Dale Johnson for this year. He was asked if he had contacted Valley Creek Mall and he had not. Tim was encouraged to talk with Dale Johnson about who to contact and make those arrangements. Once that is done, he can start lining up volunteers.
- **Joint Color Guard**
There has been a request from the Joint Color Guard to have a Lead and Coordinator. The person who was handling this is stepping back. No one volunteered for this position.

Announcements

Kelley Ackerman 3rd District Vice Commander was present at our meeting and discussed several issues. She was very impressed with our meeting and how we address issues, come to a resolution and how involved we are in the community.

She told us about Fund 85 which is a state fund that can be accessed by legion personnel in an emergency
