3. Compare and contrast the installation methods of concrete roof tile and other roofing materials.
4. Identify key performance characteristics of concrete roof tiles including safety testing, related building codes, and sustainability attributes.
5. Analyze the longevity, durability, and overall life cycle cost analysis of concrete roof tile compared to asphalt shingles, wood shakes, slate and metal.
6. Confidently specify concrete tile roofing as an alternative to slate, metal, wood shakes and temporary asphalt shingles.
