The IIBEC So Cal Chapter (formerly the So Cal Chapter of RCI, Inc.) is seeking abstracts for presentations at the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Hawaii Winter Workshop.

As we enter the second decade of the 21<sup>st</sup> century, the landscape of the building design and construction industry is rapidly changing. Shifting workforce demographics, climate change, code updates, and progress in technology, research and development continue to push the frontier of how we build buildings. Our construction methods continue to accelerate in pace and increase in sophistication and we need to ensure that buildings can meet fundamental performance requirements - air-, and water-tightness, vapor control, thermal efficiency and fire resistance, to achieve the expectations of more knowledgeable and demanding stakeholders.

The 2020 workshop will focus on how building enclosures are responding to these changes and previewing what's on the horizon. The primary workshop goal will be to provide attendees with valuable insights on the future of building enclosure design, consulting, manufacturing, and construction.

Professionals from the roofing/waterproofing consulting, architecture, engineering, manufacturing and construction community are invited to submit abstracts for presentations. Submitted abstracts should pertain to the advancement of modern building enclosures, such as the following:

- Industry trends or hot topics for roofing, waterproofing or façade systems
- Advances in investigation methods and testing techniques
- Emerging technologies and construction materials
- Building enclosure commissioning
- Construction litigation
- Regulatory changes

The updated deadline for submitting presentation proposals for consideration is **Friday September 13, 2019**. Proposals should be submitted as a 250-word (maximum) abstract. Selection emphasis will be placed on submissions with project case studies.
