The IIBEC So Cal Chapter (formerly the So Cal Chapter of RCI, Inc.) is seeking abstracts for presentations at the 22nd Annual Hawaii Winter Workshop.

The building design and construction industry is in the midst of a rapid and disruptive transformation. Recent emerging technologies, world events, regulation changes, and shifting labor trends continue to affect the way the built environment is designed, constructed, maintained and repurposed. On-going global supply chain issues and workforce availability constraints have challenged us to rethink how we can effectively meet fundamental enclosure performance requirements - air-, and water-tightness, vapor control, thermal efficiency and fire resistance, while meeting the collective expectations of all project stakeholders.

The upcoming 2023 workshop will focus on navigating dynamic changes in the building envelope industry. The primary workshop goal will be to provide attendees with valuable insight into contemporary trends within building enclosure design, consulting, manufacturing, and construction.

Professionals from the roofing/waterproofing consulting, architecture, engineering, manufacturing and construction community are invited to submit abstracts for presentations. Submitted abstracts should pertain to modern developments in building enclosure design and construction, including but not limited to the following:

- Roofing, horizontal or below-grade waterproofing, air barriers, fenestration systems, exterior cladding
- Industry trends or hot topics
- Emerging technologies, construction methods and building materials
- Advances in investigation and testing techniques
- Building sustainability and resiliency
- Constructability

The deadline for submitting presentation proposals for consideration is <u>Thursday September 22, 2022</u>. Proposals should be submitted as a 250-word (maximum) abstract.
