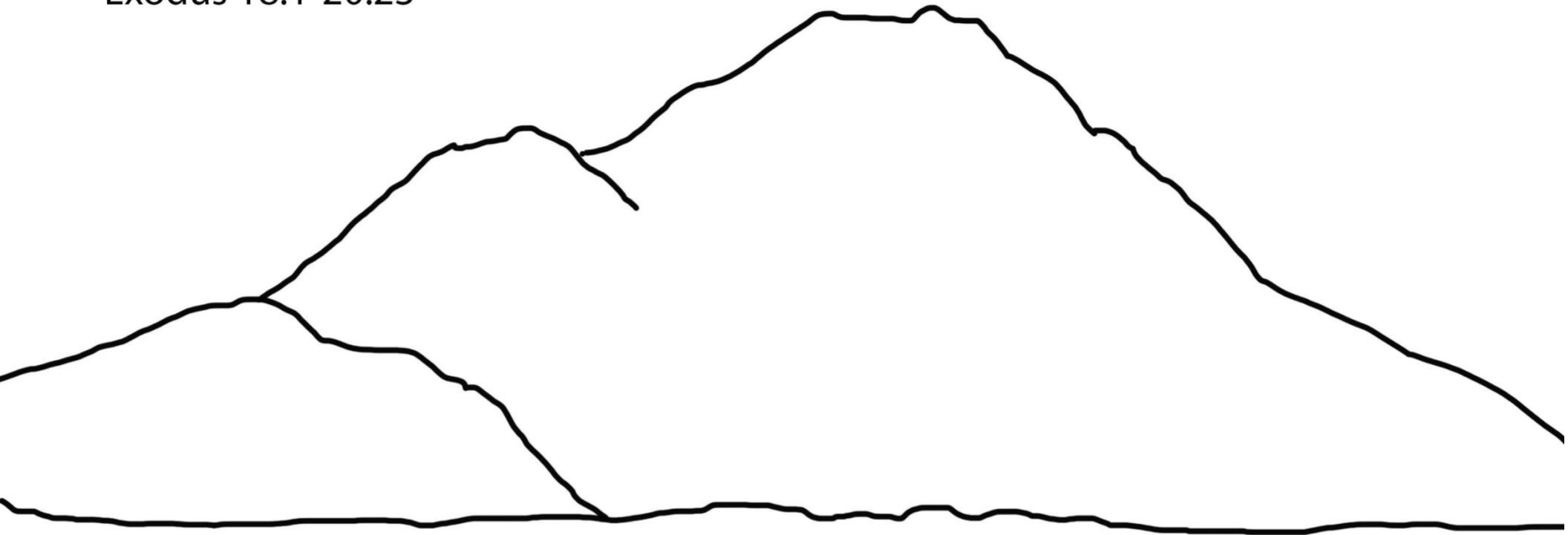

Exodus 18:1-20:23



Mapping the Portion

In Torah Portion Yitro, all the events take place around Mt. Sinai! While there wasn't much movement from the Israelites, Moses himself did quite a bit of traveling. This week's mapping is focused on his journey up and down the mountain. You will need a variety of colors to complete this picture map. You can use whichever medium you wish: crayons, pencils or markers. Mapping can be done as you reach each verse in your portion, or as a separate activity. The goal of mapping is to familiarize yourself with the geography of the land, to visualize where important Biblical events happened and to bring Bible history to life!

Exodus 18:5	Moses' father-in-law, along with Moses' wife and sons, came to him in the wilderness where he was camped at the Mountain of YHVH (God).	Draw Israel camped in the valley around the Mountain of YHVH (God). Draw a cloud around the top of Mt. Sinai.
Exodus 19:3	Moses went up the Mountain to YHVH (God)	Draw a path for Moses from the camp to the top of the Mountain.
Exodus 19:7	After Moses came back, he summoned the elders of the people and set before them all these words that the Lord has commanded him.	Draw a path for Moses from the top of the Mountain to the camp.
Exodus 19:8	Then all the people responded together, "We will do all that the Lord has spoken." So Moses brought the people's words back to the Lord.	Draw a path for Moses from the camp to the top of the Mountain.
Exodus 19:14	Then Moses came down from the mountain to the people and consecrated them, and they washed their clothes.	Draw a path for Moses from the top of the Mountain to the camp.
Exodus 19:17	Then Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain.	Draw people at the base of the mountain.
Exodus 19:20	"The Lord came down on Mount Sinai at the top of the mountain. Then the Lord summoned Moses to the top of the mountain, and he went up.	Draw a path for Moses from the camp to the top of the Mountain.
Exodus 19:24-25	And the Lord replied to him, "Go down and come back with Aaron. But the priests and the people must not break through to come up to the Lord, or He will break out in anger against them." So Moses went down to the people and told them.	Draw a path for Moses from the top of the Mountain to the camp. Draw Joshua and the Elders a little ways up the mountain.
Exodus 20:21	And the people remained standing at a distance as Moses approached the thick darkness where God was.	Draw a path for Moses from the camp to the top of the Mountain.
