## **Background Check Measures**

Throughout the COVID-19 emergency period, to encourage social distancing and stop the spread of the pandemic, the agency recommends that providers and participants limit participation in congregate settings or activities.

- 1. Direct service workers and families can begin providing authorized services to waiver participants immediately without waiting for the results of background checks.
- 2. HCBS providers may offer a provisional employment pending background checks.
  - a. Provisional employees are granted temporary exceptions to work and be paid with Medicaid funding while their background checks are pending
  - b. Applicants shall immediately disclose any/all arrests and outcomes of criminal or civil charges to the employer.
    - i. If a background check is completed during the period that this guidance is in effect, the HCBS provider/employer shall NOT employ a person who has adverse findings and/or a prohibited offense on their background check pursuant to K.S.A. 39-2009.
    - ii. In the event an individual/employee has a prohibited offense and/or an adverse finding, provisional employment to provide HCBS services shall terminate immediately.

"Exceptions granted in this guidance shall be in place until a policy rescinding them is released.".
