### **Meeting Minutes**

Call to Order. Vice-Chair David Welfelt called the meeting to order at 4:08 p.m.

Proxies: None.

Quorum Status: At the start of the meeting, a quorum was not present. Due to an incorrect Zoom link login, three directors were unable to access the meeting via Zoom. Although this would have resulted in a quorum, the inability to login was not realized until later in the meeting. As a result, no business was conducted. The January 2026 Board meeting minutes, financial reports and acknowledgement of Service Management & Director's Report will be reviewed for approval at the March 2026 Board meeting.

Kevin discussed some of the items in the Service Management & Director's Report.

Harvey-Marion TCM Update: Harvey-Marion TCM Director Jaci Schrag reported that they (Jaci along with three case managers) provide Case Management services to 115 individuals, 12 of whom do not currently have Medicaid. These 12 individuals have received \$9,000 in billable services, at no expense to them. The goal is to assist them in becoming Medicaid-eligible, and this has been accomplished for two or three. Jaci submits billing to the three MCO's on a weekly basis; since starting in September, 2025 \$108,843.75 has been billed for services provided. After having a temporary license, they had a license review last month and are now fully licensed! The case managers attended an InterHab Case Managers meeting in Topeka last week. It was a productive time of networking with case managers across the state. Looking ahead, Jaci plans to apply for licensing to provide Case Management services on the Community



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Support Waiver. CSW Case Management requires an elevated level of supports, to include monitoring the individual's annual capped service allotment of \$20,000.00. If HMTCM is approved for TCM, a dedicated case manager for CSW would be hired.

Discussed the Community Support Waiver (CSW) capacity. Initially, approximately 150 individuals who have waited the longest for IDD waiver services will receive offers. Individuals on the IDD waiver are eligible to transition to the CSW. Plans are for funding 500 slots for years one through three.
