- DATE / TIME:** Saturday and Sunday, October 8th & 9th 2022
Warm-ups start at 8:00 a.m. Meet starts at 9:00 a.m. Individual team warm-up times TBA.
- TYPE OF MEET:** Short Course 25 yards.
- FACILITIES & TIMING:** Outdoor eight (8) lane 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane ropes.
The Colorado 6000 electronic timing system will be used. This is an outdoor heated facility. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.22C(4).
- RULES:** Current USA rules will govern the conduct of the meet. Entry times to be submitted in short course yards only. NT'S will be seeded last.
- CONDITION OF SANCTION:** As a condition of this sanction, HSC agrees to comply and to enforce all COVID 19 health and safety mandates and guidelines in effect (such as face coverings, social distancing, or mass gatherings) of USA Swimming, Louisiana Swimming, the State of Louisiana, local jurisdictions, and the HSC meet plan detailed below. Meets conducted in violation of these requirements and safety plans are subject to having the sanction revoked and will not be issued sanctions for future meets during the COVID 19 sanctioning period.
- ASSUMPTION OF RISK DISCLAIMER:** HSC has taken enhanced health and safety measures for athletes, coaches, officials spectators, and others participating in this meet. You must follow all safety instructions in the following meet sanction. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID 19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID 19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the CDC, Senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By attending this meet, you assume all risks related to exposure to COVID 19.

CONDUCT OF MEET:

The meet is limited by the four-hour rule. Consequently, the 76 events may be limited and at the end of the meet, those who desire may be offered to swim those events.

EVENTS:

All events will be timed finals with no qualifying times.

REGISTRATION:

All participants must be registered USA Swimming athletes. If the birthday of a contestant is on the first day of the meet, this will determine the age group in which the swimmer shall compete for the meet. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or much start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmers legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement."

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in article 302.

ENTRIES:

A swimmer may enter three (3) individual events per day plus relays. Entries to be submitted on Hy-Tek program. There is an entry limit of 350 swimmers, per session. We will allow on deck registration as long as a new heat does not have to be formed.

ENTRY FEE:

Individual events \$5.00 & \$14.00 surcharge; \$10.00 relays. All entry fee checks must be made payable to Hurricane Swim Club Parent's Association. Heat sheets will be handled electronically. Please print before you come to the meet.

ELIGIBILITY:

HSC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules & Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistance required and/or registered service animals.

SCORING:

Individual points will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

AWARDS:

Individual events: Medals: 1st through 3rd; Ribbons: 4th through 8th;
Relays: Medals: 1st; Ribbons: 2nd through 8th.

- OFFICIALS:** All teams attending this meet are asked to supply a list of certified officials who will be attending this meet and sessions they will be able to work.
- HOSPITALITY:** There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials.
- CONCESSIONS:** Food and drink will be available to swimmers and spectators for purchase.
- TIMERS:** All teams will be required to assist with timers for use during the meet.
- WARM-UP:** In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, each lane must be supervised by a team representative who is a member of USA Swimming. They must be at the diving end of the pool. Diving is from the block end only. Warm down lanes will be provided in the 6 lane pool in designated lanes only. **NO HORSEPLAY OR DIVING IS ALLOWED IN THE WARM DOWN AREA.**
- WAIVER/RELEASE:** As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and Louisiana Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you are responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. HSC, Louisiana Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any and all of your teams' swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych sheets, Meet results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.
- USA MEMBERSHIP:** All coaches attending the meet in an official capacity as a head or assistant coach of entered team must be USA certified. Proof of certification may be required by the referee.
- WATER DEPTH:** Water is 5 feet deep at diving block end and 4 feet deep at shallow end. The water is 5 and ½ feet deep in the middle
- CONDUCT:** The LSI Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must

start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials, and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

MAAP:

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

TECH SUIT BAN FOR 12 & UNDERS

Per LSI Rule 210.2, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Tech suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.
