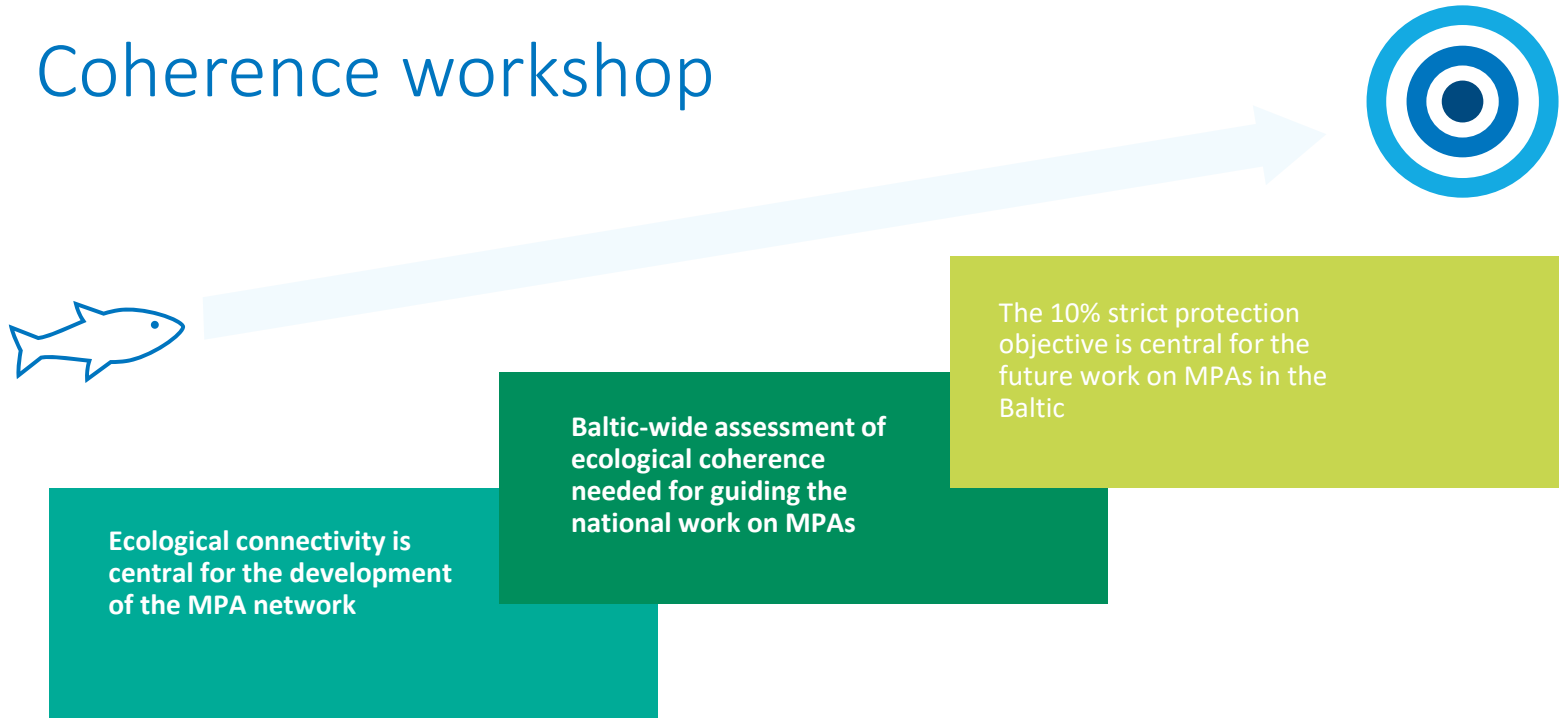


Monitoring is very important tool for managing the MPAs
