Deposit and Payment

By placing this deposit of \$500, the buyer agrees to the following:

1. The deposit is non-refundable.
In the event that your puppy becomes ill or dies while at the breeder's kennel, your deposit will go toward another puppy in the litter (if available) or transfer to a future litter of equal quality.
2. Breeders reserve the right to refund the deposit and refuse sale at any time if the breeder feels it is no longer in the puppy's best interest to be placed with the buyer.
3. Puppy must be paid in full before he/she leaves our kennel.

Health Guarantee

1. Your puppy will leave our kennel healthy to the best of our knowledge.
2. In case of transport your puppy will leave with a veterinarian health certificate
3. The buyer agrees to take the puppy to a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours from the date and time of receiving the puppy and report it back to the breeder.
4. If in the first 72-hours the buyer is dissatisfied with the puppy for any reason, the puppy can be returned to our kennel for a refund of the original purchase price less the non-refundable \$500 deposit (no refunds after 72-hour period)
5. All transportation costs are the buyer's responsibility.

The following are not part of the 72-hour guarantee

1. This guarantee does not cover what is considered normal for this breed such as: Cherry eye, Entropion, Skin allergies, Bloat, Ear Infections
2. Normal puppy maladies such as: Parasites, worms, ringworm, giardia, coccidia
3. Minor physical defects such as: navel or inguinal hernias, uneven bites, undescended testicles, type I or II heart murmurs, or any other non-life-threatening problems
4. Under no circumstance shall the breeder be liable for consequential, incidental, or special damages resulting from negligence and environmental factors such as: poor temperament due to lack of training and socialization, weight, jumping, autoimmune disorders, starvation, neglect, etc.
5. The breeder will not be responsible for contagious diseases such as: Parvo, Distemper, Corona Virus, Kennel Cough, or scabies as they are highly contagious and can be contacted immediately.

Health care

1. Your puppy will be raised on **Purina Pro Plan Puppy** and is recommended to stay on this kibble until 12-month-old. Afterwards we recommend a Purina large breed diet.
2. Your puppy has been vaccinated for distemper/parvo at 6 weeks, to complete the vaccination the puppy needs three more rounds including rabies with the last dose (which exact week is up to your veterinarian since the preference differ)
3. Your puppy has had deworming treatments every 2 weeks from birth with PPO.
4. We recommend the buyer takes the puppy every year to a licensed veterinarian for annual shots and health exams and reports back to the breeder
5. We recommend cleaning the ears regularly with alcohol-based cleaners to prevent yeast build up
6. We recommend supplementing any dog food you choose with Multivitamins (such as Revival products)
