### **Impact:**

- Advanced suicide prevention training for Rockwood School District teachers and staff
- Brought to the attention of Senator Jill Schupp the epidemic of youth suicides in our state, resulting in two hours of mandated training for all teachers and counselors in Missouri
- Over the past two years presented to more than 2,000 youth, parents, and teachers/staff and currently serves the following school districts: Parkway, Rockwood, Valley Park, Premier Charter Schools, and Confluence Academy
- Hosted awareness events with more than 5,000 participants
- Awarded \$36,000 in scholarships for students who were actively involved in suicide prevention
