As we prepare to gather in Albany for the 30th Session of the Western New York Annual Conference, we recognize that many attendees will be traveling, planning schedules, and coordinating with their congregations.

The following questions and answers are offered to help you prepare well for your arrival, your worship, and your participation in the work of the Conference.

When do we convene?

We gather Tuesday, April 28, for the Conference Welcome Reception at 5 p.m. at Israel A.M.E. Church.

This opening gathering will provide an opportunity for fellowship and welcome before the Ministry of Evangelism Worship Service starts at 6:30 p.m.

Where will Conference events take place?

Conference events will take place in two locations in Albany.

Where should I plan to park?

Street parking will be available near both churches.

Reserved parking at Metropolitan will be available for Episcopal leadership, Western New York pastors, and designated conference leadership. Additional parking will be available nearby on a first-come, first-served basis.

Do I need to register to attend?

Yes! Preregistration helps the Conference prepare appropriately for worship, fellowship, and the work of the sessions.

Will Conference services be available online?
