
Halsey Chase Herreshoff



About 65 years ago, in the mid 1950's, a young and ambitious man named Halsey
Chase Herreshoff found himself embarking on an incredible journey in the United States
Navy. Born into a family with a rich maritime legacy, Halsey has sailing in his blood, and
the call of the sea was hard to resist. It's hard to know where to start with someone like
Halsey who has accomplished and experienced so much during his lifetime. A Rhode
Islander all his life, Halsey learned to sail when he was two years old and started racing
at the age of five in Bristol.

After attending the Webb Institute, Halsey later earned a naval architecture and mechanical engineering graduate degree at MIT. Even more impressive are his contributions to yachting chronicled in the *Encyclopedia of Yacht Designers*. More than 9,500 boats have been commissioned based on his family's designs.

Halsey had always been fascinated by ships and the vastness of the ocean. He dreamed of adventures beyond the horizon, and the Navy seemed like the perfect place to turn those dreams into reality. With determination and a thirst for knowledge, he enlisted in 1956 and soon began his training on the minesweeping missions aboard the *USS Guide*.

During his eight year tenure in the Navy, Halsey faced various challenges, both physical and mental. He learned the art of navigation through a sextant, honed his leadership skills, and fostered a deep sense of camaraderie with his fellow cadets. Despite the grueling demands of the training, Halsey's passion for the sea only grew stronger with each passing day.

Halsey recalls during our interview, "Life on a Navy ship is always interesting. As an Ensign you start to get involved and learn things, at one point you get to be the commander of the deck. The day I achieved this honor was the most satisfying!"

Halsey set sail on his first deployment in 1956 in patrol squadron 19. He found himself aboard a state-of-the-art destroyer, patrolling the vast oceans and protecting his country's interests. The sense of duty and responsibility weighed heavily on his shoulders as commander of the ship. During our interview he told us a story about a very stormy night, "One miserable night in the middle of the winter near the coast of Korea...it was so rough and freezing cold, the waves were immense. You are never supposed to sit in the commanding officer's chair! But I had to do this because it was

the one time I was feeling unwell, although I have never actually gotten seasick. Sometimes you have to do what you have to do! "

As the years passed, Halsey's career in the Navy progressed rapidly. His talent as a leader and his remarkable grasp of naval operations earned him the respect and admiration of his superiors and peers alike. He climbed through the ranks, demonstrating exceptional skill and earning several commendations for his bravery and strategic process.

Halsey stated, "Like my grandfather said, You are a damn fool if you make the same mistake twice!" Halsey feels The United States Navy is a fine institution that allows young adults to have exceptional responsibility and leadership responsibilities at an early age. He mentioned that prior to that experience, "I had never had that level of responsibility. At the age of 22, I was the commander of a ship. What an exceptional responsibility as a young man!"

Halsey was an engineering officer Aboard the *USS Guide, an 187 foot* minesweeper with a crew of about 65 men and women in the Pacific Ocean. This ship was entirely made of wood. Halsey recalled how they taught us to stand in the event of a mine explosion during a minesweeper Naval exercise. He mentioned that, "I still stand with my knees a little bent to this day, because of the way they instructed us to protect ourselves in the event of an explosion."


Halsey's experience in the US Navy also brought him face to face with some of the earth's most beautiful natural beauty. From breathtaking sunsets over the Pacific to nights spent navigating by the stars. He found solace and wonder in the beauty of the ocean. These experiences further deepened his connection with the sea and solidified his love for sailing.

His ability to remain level-headed in critical moments and make swift, calculated decisions garnered him a reputation as one of the Navy's most trusted naval engineering Lieutenant Commanders. Eventually, after a distinguished career in the Navy, Halsey returned to private life but continued to be involved in maritime endeavors, embracing his family's sailing legacy and working to promote sailing as a sport and a way of life. He went on to work for Time magazine, where he authored the definitive guide "How to Work a Sextant", and to become Mayor of the Town of Bristol.

Halsey started a maritime museum located in Bristol named "The Herreshoff Marine Museum and The America's Cup Hall of Fame". The museum remains the leading attraction in Bristol and features many designs from his family's extensive accomplishments in naval architecture. Halsey continues to support this and many other maritime educational institutions and is a frequent guest lecturer.

Halsey's time in the Navy also instilled a tremendous respect for the flag and inspired expertise in flag etiquette. He still proudly displays, next to his desk, an American flag from one of the six America's Cup campaigns he competed in.

Halsey's passion for the sea led him on a remarkable journey in the United States Navy, inspired important naval designs, and continues to this day. Turning 90 years old on September 06th, 2023, Halsey is still captaining boats, both power and sail. He talks with young students and continues to inspire all those who have the pleasure of meeting him. His infectious smile, charming laugh and humble demeanor brings a smile to my face when you are able to spend time with him.



The U.S.S. GUIDE is one of the ships of the Navy's newest class of minesweepers. The 173-foot, wooden-hulled ship was built by the Seattle Shipbuilding and Drydocking Corporation of Seattle, Washington. Her keel was laid on 20 February 1953, and she was launched on 17 April 1954, with Miss Ann Larsen the sponsor. Following trials and inspections, the ship was accepted by the Navy on 25 February 1955. The GUIDE is designated an Ocean Minesweeper and is capable of carrying out all types of minesweeping missions and operating as an independent unit of the Fleet. Upon completion of training and readying for sea, the ship will join the U.S. Pacific Fleet.
